

## SUGGESTIONS FOR PACE OF PLAY

1. KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU. IF YOU FALL BEHIND A HOLE PICK UP YOUR PACE. IN WEEKLY GAMES IF YOU ARE OUT OF THE HOLE, IE YOUR SCORE DOES NOT COUNT, PICK UP AND RECORD A NET DOUBLE BOGEY.
2. RULES 5.6B AND 6.4B ENCOURAGES READY GOLF FROM START OF HOLE TO FINISH OF HOLE, THAT INCLUDES THE PUTTING GREEN, UNLESS YOU ARE IN SOMEONE ELSE'S LINE OR IN MATCH PLAY OR OTHER TOURNAMENT COMPETITION.
3. DO NOT WAIT FOR THE DRIVER TO TAKE YOU TO YOUR BALL. DO NOT WAIT FOR YOUR RIDING PARTNER TO HIT THEIR BALL. GRAB YOUR CLUBS AND RANGE FINDER AND SAFELY WALK TO YOUR BALL AND BE READY TO HIT.
4. KEEP YOUR PRE SHOT ROUTINE SHORT AND AIM TO PLAY YOUR BALL WITHIN 20 SECONDS.
- 5 WATCH YOUR TEAMATES BALL FLIGHT, OFFER TO RAKE THE BUNKERS FOR YOUR TEAMATES. STRICTLY ADHERE TO THE 3 MINUTE RULE WHEN LOOKING FOR LOST BALLS.
6. LINE UP YOUR PUTT WHILE OTHERS ARE PUTTING. YOU MAY PLACE YOUR BALL ON THE GREEN TO LINE UP A PUTT AS LONG AS IT IS NOT IN SOMEONE ELSE'S LINE OR A DISTRACTION TO THEM. YOU MAY CHOOSE TO USE CONTINUOUS PUTTING WHEN PUTTING DISTANCE IS TWO FEET OR LESS.
7. IF YOUR GROUP HAS FALLEN BEHIND THEN THE FIRST TWO WHO HAVE PUTT OUT SHOULD GO TO THE NEXT TEE BOX TOGETHER AND HIT THEIR DRIVES.
8. ALWAYS HIT A PROVISIONAL BALL IF YOU THINK YOUR BALL IS LOST OR OUT OF BOUNDS.
9. SCAN THE GREEN BEFORE WALKING OFF FOR CLUBS LEFT BEHIND.
